I appreciate the opportunity to have served on the EC for 12 years and would love to be reelected to assist the current Executive Committee in all the current endeavors that are impacting our citizens. I have a great desire to work for our people and I am always available to our people, day and night. I have been an active member of the Executive Committee from visiting all entities including Head Start, the Senior Center, and tribal members on a regular basis. I look forward to the opportunity to help lead this Nation for the next 3 years if elected.
